

# WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP WHITSETT

## MANDATORY ITEMS

Merit Badge Prerequisite Forms Notebook, Paper, Pens\*

Mess Kit\* (plate, bowl, cup and utensils)  
Flashlight\*

## CLOTHING

Scout Uniform Required for travel & evening meals  
Pajamas  
Sweater/Jacket\*  
Hat or Visor\*  
Jeans or warm pants  
T-Shirts (min. 3, including Class B)\*  
Shorts (min. 2)  
Swim Suit and Towel  
Hiking Shoes and Socks/Tennis Shoes  
Water Shoes (or old tennies)/ Socks (min. 4 pair)/ Undergarments (min. 6 pair)

## CAMPING GEAR

Sleeping Bag (optional sleeping pad if can fit into your duffle—there are bunks)

## TOILET KIT

Toothpaste and Toothbrush\* Soap and Shampoo\* Medication (if needed)  
Bath Towels/Washcloth Emergency Toilet Paper Deodorant\*  
Shaving Gear  
Comb/Small Mirror Sunscreen\*  
Chap-stick\* (very important!)

## MISCELLANEOUS

O/A Sash  
Camera\*  
Flashlight Batteries\* Compass\*  
Scout Knife\*  
Water Bottle\*  
Daypack\*  
Watch  
Fishing Tackle\*  
Spending Money - \$75-\$100 recommended

**NOTE: If taking Lifesaving, Swimming, or Canoeing MB** bring extra clothes for survival in the water: long pants, long-sleeved shirt, socks, shoes.

***Cargo space is limited.***  
*Each scout will be allowed one duffle bag, one small daypack (optional), and one sleeping bag. Scouts will carry their gear into the camp, as only one vehicle is allowed in—make sure you can do it in one trip).*
